Ragging is strictly prohibited in JSPM group of Institutes

Action against Ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999

Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and/or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees. Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such students shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.

As per “UGC Regulation on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009” the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

1. Suspension from attending classes & academic privileges
2. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits
3. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
4. Withholding results
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
6. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel
7. Cancellation of admission
8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period
10. Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1lakh
11. Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Eligibility Criteria

For admission to Direct Second Year B.Pharm

1. Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates and All India Candidature Candidates

- i. The candidate should be a citizen of India;
- ii. The candidate should have passed in D.Pharm course from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy act 1948 (8 of 1948); and
- iii. Any other eligibility criteria and requirement declared from time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act.

Admission Procedure

Candidates shall be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) as per Inter-se-merit carried out by Competent Authority of Government of Maharashtra.

Rules for Admissions in Institutional Quota and Vacant seats after CAP.—

The admissions for these seats will be carried out in the following manner as per information brochure for admission to Under Graduate Technical Courses (2025-26). Government of Maharashtra State Common Entrance Test Cell.

(a) Admissions shall be made in a transparent manner and strictly as per the Inter-Se Merit of the Candidates who have applied to Competent Authority for verification of documents and then to the Institution.

(b) Information brochure or prospectus of the Institution which specifies rules of admission should be published well before the commencement of the process of admission. All the information in the brochures should also be displayed on the Institution's website.

(c) Institution shall invite applications till date of allotment of final CAP round by notifying schedule of admission and the number of seats in each course to be filled by the institution, by advertisement on the website of the institution.

(d) Aspiring candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria as notified by the Government and specified by the appropriate authority, from time to time, shall apply to the respective institution for admission at the Institution level as provided clause (b) of sub rule (4) of rule 3 and shall be filled in on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit prepared by following the procedure specified in sub rule (3) of rule 8 of these rules.

Provided that, in case a candidate is unable to submit the application directly to the concerned institution for any reason, the candidate shall have the opportunity to apply through the website of the Competent Authority till the date of allotment of final CAP Round. These applications will be forwarded to the respective institutions after the allotment process of CAP Round -IV. The concerned institution shall consider such applications while preparing the inter-se-merit.

(e) The institution after verification of all required documents shall prepare and display the Inter-Se-Merit lists of the Candidates to be filled in at the institution level, in the Institutional Quota and Supernumerary Quota of OCI / PIO, Foreign National, Children's of Indian workers in Gulf Countries along with the vacant seats after CAP, on the notice board and shall publish the same on the website of the institution

(f) The Minority or Non-Minority institution intending to surrender the Institutional Quota (in part or full) of specified courses to the CAP shall communicate two days before the display of seat matrix of each CAP Round I and the same shall be allotted as per the rules of CAP. The Institutes shall not be allowed to surrender Institutional quota seats thereafter.

(g) All the admissions and cancellations shall be updated immediately through online system.

(h) If any CAP seat remains or becomes vacant after the CAP Rounds, then the same shall be filled in by the Candidate from the same Category for which it was earmarked during the CAP. Further if the seats remain vacant then the seats shall be filled on the basis of Inter-Se Merit of the applicants.



(i) While filing these seats, the preference shall be given to Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates over All India Candidature Candidates on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit.

(j) After exhausting Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates over All India Candidature Candidates, if any seat remain vacant in the Sanctioned Intake then these seats may be filled with NRI, Foreign Students (FS), Overseas Citizen of India (OCI), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO), Children of Indian Workers in the Gulf Countries (CIWGC) Candidature Candidates, if the institute has secured prior approval from appropriate authority for these seats.
